**BIDDERS NUMBER ALLOCATED**

PROPERTY, STOCK and BUSINESS AGENTS ACT 2002

Section 67 Bids may only be taken from registered bidders

- (1) The auctioneer at a sale by auction of residential property or rural land must not take a bid from a person unless:
  - (a) the relevant details of the person have been entered before the bid is taken in a Bidders Record made in respect of the auction in accordance with section 68, and the auctioneer is in possession of that record when the bid is taken,
  - and
  - (b) the person is identified at the auction by the person displaying an identifying number allocated to the person for the purposes of the auction and recorded in the Bidders Record as the identifying number allocated to that person.

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
